### "I wanted to rewind time and erase the fact that I had ever gone to that abortion clinic."

Taylor<sup>\*</sup> remembers it like it was yesterday. At 8 p.m. sharp on November 7, 2018, she took a pregnancy test and there was an immediate positive. "My first reaction was fear," Taylor remembers. "My mind began to flood with doubt and negative thoughts, like not being able to afford a child or finish college. In that moment it seemed that abortion was my best route. I thought that I could have my life back and nothing would affect it. I wanted to keep it between me and God and tell no one."

The next day, Taylor called All Women's Health Clinic in Baltimore MD, and scheduled an abortion for November 17 at 7 a.m. She was the first patient that day, which was fine. She wanted to do it quickly and get it over with. But it wasn't as easy as she had hoped. Not even one minute after they called her into the back of the clinic, Taylor broke down in tears. "As the nurse checked the sonogram, I remember her saying that I was 7 weeks and 3 days pregnant."

After the sonogram, Taylor met with another nurse to discuss her need for the abortion. Taylor was crying and had difficulty answering his questions. She knew in her spirit what she was doing was wrong. "The nurse told me that 'it's my body, it's my choice. That's why you are here because you are choosing to make the right decision for you.' He said I needed to learn to put myself before others."

Finally, Taylor met with the doctor, who explained that there are 5 pills she would need for the abortion. The first pill was to be taken in front of the doctor; it would stop the pregnancy hormone progesterone, which the baby needs to live and grow. She was instructed to place the other four pills in the vaginal area to cause contractions and complete the abortion. "I took the first pill in front of her and then I left," Taylor says. "On the way home, I couldn't stop crying. I was an emotional wreck. I knew what I had done was completely wrong."

"I didn't want to take the second dose of pills. I wanted to rewind time and erase the fact that I had ever gone to that abortion clinic. I cried so much that I felt sick." Taylor searched online for 'how to save a baby's life if you took the abortion pill' and an ad came up for the Pregnancy Clinic. She read the reviews on the website, saw they were all positive, and made the call.

Taylor was immediately connected with a nurse. She told her how she felt so terrible and wanted to stop the abortion. "I would have done anything for my baby to live," Taylor says. "I needed my baby to live! I kept apologizing to God over and over and over again and begging him to please help me save this baby's life."

The next day, she drove to the Pregnancy Clinic and met with the nurse and a counselor. Taylor sobbed as she told them how scared she was to be a mom, but that she wanted to try to save her baby's life. The clinic staff took action immediately to "reverse" the abortion, . "They were very reassuring and supportive," Taylor remembers. "They were with me every single step of the way."

"And now when I look at my son Isaac, I am so thankful that the Lord blessed me with him and guided me to the Pregnancy Clinic, because without them, Isaac would not be here. I am so glad they were able to save my little man because I couldn't imagine life without him."
