to a screeching halt late one autumn night as she sat on the cold floor of her bathroom with a positive pregnancy test in her hand. "I was in complete shock," Rebecca remembers. "It felt like I was watching a bad movie that I couldn't turn off. My thoughts ran wild with disbelief and fear. This couldn't be real; this couldn't be happening to me."

Rebecca soon realized that the baby's father did not want to be involved. She was alone. "I was terrified and didn't know what to do. I decided not to tell anyone while I tried to figure out my options." Rebecca had heard of the Pregnancy Clinic from her church and decided to make an appointment. The volunteer counselor she met with encouraged her to tell her family about her pregnancy, and continued to reach out to Rebecca to check on her.

"She would always ask if I had talked with my family yet," Rebecca recalls. "Every time she called I told her that I hadn't told anyone and I still hadn't decided what I was going to do. Though I didn't want to hear it at the time, God was using her to speak to me. Her persistence and continued support helped me to eventually accept my pregnancy and share with my family and friends. Once I did, *everything changed*. I was met with incredible love and acceptance - and I could feel God's love and acceptance for me through them. I decided to keep my baby. I knew that even without a dad in his life my child would be deeply cared for by me, my family, my friends and most importantly, his Heavenly Father."

Rebecca's son was born in 2013, and she has been a single mom since. She graduated with her master's degree while eight months pregnant and now works full time as an Early Childhood Behavior Consultant. It hasn't been easy and although she has had many challenges along the way, Rebecca shares that there have also been many blessings.

"Holding my son for the first time was the most wonderful moment of my life. I felt instantly connected to him and I was filled with more love than I ever knew was possible. My son is growing up to be an incredible little man. He is bursting with energy and excitement. He is passionate, creative, smart and determined. He enjoys drawing pictures to create books and making movies with his kid's video camera. He loves animals and is obsessed with everything related to dinosaurs."

Rebecca's son was diagnosed with ADHD and Anxiety, which have produced many difficulties and challenges over the past few years. "I work hard to provide him with the daily structure, routine and support he needs to be successful. I support school staff and families of young children who are experiencing challenging behaviors. God has tied my challenges and my career together so that I can help others from what I have learned professionally as well as personally."

"In 2015, I decided to take the Pregnancy Clinic Volunteer Training Class and see where God would have me be involved with the ministry that had done so much for me. I now teach the Successful Single Parenting LifeSense Class. I love to connect with and encourage the moms in my classes."

In 2018, she expanded her outreach by starting a blog for single moms, and is now working on a devotional book to show God's great love for them and the beautiful life he has planned. "I encourage them to look for the good and seek God when life is challenging."

Buckle up, because life going forward for a time is going to be a rough ride.

The new sheriff in town and his administration celebrate their support of Big Abortion. Across the board is a slate of pro-abort cabinet positions, chief among them A.G. Becerra, who spearheaded California's effort to force Pregnancy Centers to promote and refer for abortion services. Thankfully we won the Supreme Court case of NIFLA v. Becerra.

However, now that they are in power, this attack on Pregnancy Clinic work will come back with a vengeance. Medical abortions by pill are becoming Big Abortion's preferred method. We saw this push for distribution recently rear its ugly head in Maryland with a slate of bills this session to allow the abortion pill to be dispensed to young teens, like candy from a Pez dispenser.

Fewer constraints, combined with government funding, will only lead to an increase in the number of abortions - not only in Maryland, but nationally and internationally. Only the supposed majority of conservative justices on the Supreme Court can now serve as a block to the most radical abortion agenda ever empowered in DC.

The immediate future looks grim and hopeless.

And this is *exactly* how the women we care for imagine their lives will be if they say Yes to their unexpected pregnancy. We have been called to walk in the hard places with women considering abortion - to proclaim truth, hope, and life. We can help her be brave – to say No to her fears and Yes to this preborn baby.

We are called to be the face of Jesus to her, stretching out our hand with that cool glass of water and the Good News. Yet these very words of counsel we give her, we need to tell ourselves. God has got this!

While we don't know exactly how God will work in her situation, we know He will, and we trust with confidence that the Lord's plans for her involve 'a hope and a future' (Jer. 29:11). And as we feel the weight of the uncertainty of tomorrow, we must draw assurance and strength from the One we know holds our future.

With trust in the Lord we will face this and fight this - come what may. In Christ,
