When Ava saw the plus sign on the home pregnancy test, her heart sank. She was a single mom with many challenges in her life and another child was not in her plans at the time. Although in her heart she knew abortion was wrong, she was very early in her pregnancy and the abortion pill seemed to be an easy solution.

Her boyfriend was astonished by her reaction and begged her not to have an abortion. Ava was conflicted but remained determined to get the abortion pill.

She went to Planned Parenthood in Annapolis, right across the street from the Annapolis Women's Clinic. Accompanied by her boyfriend, she remained resolute despite his objections and what she knew in her heart to be wrong.

When she arrived at Planned Parenthood her determination began to waiver and she began to have second thoughts. Ava says she was seen by a nurse who told her that abortions were "normal" and that many women go through it.

According to the nurse, Ava should take the first pill at the abortion clinic and the next one at home - but they did not have any bottled water to give her, so Ava was instructed to take both pills when she got home. The nurse also emphasized that once she took the pill, "There is no going back." Ava took the first pill when she left Planned Parenthood and went to bed.

When Ava awoke the next day, she instantly thought, "What have I done?" Overwhelmed by remorse and regret, she fell to her knees and begged God to forgive her and save her baby. She and her boyfriend immediately started looking online for help. Ava was hopeful that she could undo what she had done, but she kept recalling the words of the abortion nurse: "There is no going back." Eventually, Ava and her boyfriend found the Abortion Pill Rescue hotline. Ava was connected with the Annapolis Women's Clinic,

ironically directly across the street from where her ordeal began. We were able to see her right away and begin the Abortion Pill Reversal protocol.

Ava was eager and grateful to begin taking the medications that could save her baby's life. She said she she knew God had answered her prayers when they saw the beating heart of her baby on the ultrasound.

Throughout her difficult pregnancy, Ava was committed to the APR protocol and she and her boyfriend rejoiced at every milestone. Despite her anxiety that she would lose the baby, she asked God again for help, and each ultrasound revealed the baby was healthy and growing, with that strong little heartbeat.

Baby 'G' is now 8 months old, with adoring parents and a large extended family. Ava can't imagine life without her.

"I'm just so grateful for her... Women need to know that this clinic can help. God answered our prayers and she is here, she was saved."

Announcing our refresh to "Women's Clinics"

We are very excited to announce that after 42 years, we are refreshing from Pregnancy Clinic to... Women's Clinics! Some of you have seen, read or heard us talking about this, but for those who haven't I wanted to take this opportunity to share further.

Last year when we added our umbrella ministry name of Wellspring Life we knew the dust needed to settle before we completed step 2 of refreshing the names of our clinic locations from Pregnancy Clinics to Women's Clinics. Each individual location is simply now:

Annapolis Women's Clinic * Bowie Crofton Women's Clinic * Severna Park Women's Clinic

This is the final step in the Strategic Plan which began in January of 2020, to better reach and meet the needs of the women we see today. I know in my heart I will forever remember and treasure the name as Pregnancy Clinic, but there are many valuable reasons for the change and it was undertaken with much thought and prayer. A few of the factors the Board of Directors considered in making this change were:

The pregnant at risk for abortion woman is and will always be our primary mission field: to save women and preborn babies from abortion. Yet when someone reads 'Pregnancy Clinic', it can appear that is all we are about. When we began in 1982, we only offered services directly related to Pregnancy, and that is no longer the case as our services have expanded - including the most recent, our Thriving Women's Wellness Care, which offers non-pregnant women breast exams. Pap tests, and other holistic care and counseling from a biblical worldview.

National studies have shown an improved positive response from abortion-vulnerable women to names without 'pregnancy' in them - because at the moment - they do not want to be pregnant. We are also seeing immediate positive responses not only from women, but local organizations, such as being asked recently to present information to our Anne Arundel County Health Department.



We know our challenge is those who control Google and social media, also support those who own Big Abortion businesses, but we press on in the battle over reaching the pregnant abortion-vulnerable women first.

We are praying for positive reactions from women in our communities as they further see us for our compassionate holistic care, as we know when they do, the word will spread among their spheres of influence and when more women who are pregnant and abortion vulnerable learn of us, they will turn to us FIRST.

Update: Thriving Women

In April 2023, Wellspring Life Ministry launched our newest program: Thriving Women Wellness Care. Thriving Women offers free medical services to women in our community (see infographic, at right).

Since launching:

- 24 women have received STD/HIV testing and treatment;
- 18 women who had no insurance or access to care have received a Well Women's checkup and testing; and
- 1 woman has been diagnosed with a pre-cancerous lesion and referred for additional testing.

"It is a privilege to serve women and care for them holistically - physical, emotional, and spiritual," shared Jen Willhite, the Ministry's Nurse Manager. "[Our Nurse Practitioner] Lianna has been such a blessing and has initiated many spiritual conversations with our clients. Plus, she speaks Spanish! I am excited to see what God will do in the future."
